#### **Description:**

Ducks Unlimited Canada (DUC) is selling 159.72 acres of land legally described as SW 36-05-29 WPM. The property is located approximately 3 miles northeast of Tilston, MB, along Range Road 169W (RM of Two Borders). The 2024 property tax for this quarter was a total of \$971.79.

Approximately 84.70 acres were seeded to tame hay on this property in spring of 2025. Existing habitats present on site include 50.22 acres of native grassland/scrub and 24.8 acres wetland/slough. Estimated habitat acre break-down is outlined within the sketch plan map on page 5.

#### Please Note:

1) This property will be sold subject to the registration of a Conservation Agreement (CA) on the transferred title. The CA will be a No Break, No Drain agreement with a Tame Forage clause that protects habitat from breaking and draining but allows for rejuvenation of the tame hay stand once every 10 years. The purchaser will sign the Conservation Agreement as a condition of sale.





- 2) There are no cutting or grazing restrictions on the land. Property can be used for pasture and/or hay.
- 3) Two previously drained wetlands were restored with small earth plugs (red dots on sketch plan on page 5). These earth plugs may not be disturbed or removed as part of the conservation agreement terms and conditions.
- 4) A 5-acre parcel will be excluded from the conservation agreement lands to allow for future building sites. This excluded area will be mutually agreed upon by DUC and the potential purchaser.




#### Map indicating location of SW 36-05-29 WPM






## Aerial Photo – SW 36-05-29 WPM

RM of Two Borders SW 36-05-29 WPM 159.72 acres

There are approximately 84.70 acres in tame hay with another 50.22 acres of native/natural grass. The remaining 24.8 acres are comprised of small wetland basins, scattered throughout the property. Tame forage stand was sown/established in 2025. One existing dugout is present within native pasture area. Property being sold subject to the registration of a 'No Break, No Drain' Conservation Easement Agreement. Cultivation of tame forage will be permitted once every 10 years for rejuvenation purposes. No restrictions with respect to haying or grazing. One five-acre parcel will be excluded from the Conservation Agreement to allow for future building/yard site development.
