Description:

Ducks Unlimited Canada (DUC) is selling 392 acres of land legally described as NE 22-3-24 WPM, SW 27-3-24 WPM & W ½ of SE 27-3-24 WPM. The properties are located approximately 6 miles northwest of Deloraine, MB, along Township Road 16N and Range Road 141W (Municipality of Brenda-Waskada). The 2024 property tax for these properties totaled \$2,946.97.

The property is comprised of 149.92 acres of wetland and 242.08 acres of cultivated farmland. **Purchaser agrees to seed all cultivated acres down to forage by spring of 2027.** Estimated habitat acre break-down is outlined within the sketch plan maps on pages 4-6. Cultivated acres are identified as 'Non-Habitat' in these maps.




Please Note:

- 1) This property will be sold subject to the registration of a Conservation Agreement (CA) on the transferred title. Purchaser agrees to seed all 149.92 cultivated acres down to tame forage by spring of 2027. These, along with the wetland acres, will form the Conservation Agreement. The CA will be a 'No Break, No Drain' agreement with a Tame Forage clause that protects habitat from breaking and draining but allows for rejuvenation of the tame hay stand once every 10 years. The purchaser will sign the Conservation Agreement as a condition of sale.
- 2) Purchaser will be responsible for establishment of tame forage and all associated costs.
- 3) There are no cutting or grazing restrictions on the land. Property can be used for pasture and/or hay.
- 4) A 5-acre parcel will be excluded from the Conservation Agreement lands on each quarter to allow for future building/yard sites. These excluded areas will be mutually agreed upon by DUC and the potential purchaser.




Map indicating locations of NE 22-3-24 WPM, SW 27-3-24 WPM & W ½ of SE 27-3-24 WPM.






Aerial Photo - NE 22-3-24 WPM, SW 27-3-24 WPM & W ½ of SE 27-3-24 WPM.






Sketch Plan - W 1/2 of SE 27-03-24 WPM






Sketch Plan - SW 27-03-24 WPM

LAND FOR SALE BY TENDER

Ducks Unlimited Canada (DUC) has the following land for sale by tender:

Municipality of Brenda-Waskada NE 22-3-24 WPM, SW 27-3-24 WPM & W ½ of SE 27-3-24 WPM

392 acres

Two and a half quarter-sections of land for sale. Property contains approximately 242 cultivated acres and 150 acres of low-lying marsh/wetland. Property being sold subject to the registration of a Conservation Easement Agreement. Bidders must choose one of two options:

Ducks Unlimited Canada places a Conservation Easement Agreement on the WETLAND ACRES ONLY
(150 acres). Under this option, no restrictions will be placed on the cultivated cropland. Property can be
used for annual grain production if desired. Cultivation into wetlands is also permitted but these ponds must
not be drained or filled.

OR

2) Buyer agrees to seed the 242 cultivated acres to forage by spring of 2027 and have DUC place a Conservation Easement Agreement on the entire property. Under this option, the land may be used for haying and/or livestock grazing. DUC would allow cultivation of tame forage after 10 years, for stand rejuvenation purposes. Once broken, these acres must be seeded back to hay after 2 years of cropping. Forage acres would then remain intact for another 10-year term, before being eligible for rejuvenation once more. Five-acre parcels will be excluded from the Conservation Easement lands on each quarter section to allow for future yard site/building development. Buyer will be responsible for forage establishment and associated costs.

Bidders must clearly indicate which option they are selecting and <u>base their offer accordingly</u>. All bids will be considered by DUC, regardless of option chosen.

Written sealed tenders are to be mailed or dropped off to the address below. Please indicate 'Land Tender – Municipality of Brenda-Waskada' on envelope. Bids may also be emailed to Ducks Unlimited at du_brandon@ducks.ca. Be sure to place "Manitoba Land Tender Bid" in the email's subject line. Interested parties should rely on their own inspection of the property. Bids on individual quarters will not be accepted. Highest or any tender not necessarily accepted.
